Veterinary Clinic

TPP would have a full-service, low-cost veterinary clinic to care for pets. All costs would be transparent with no hidden fees or surprise bills.



A much-needed mobile veterinary clinic that can provide basic exams, dental, spay, neuter & vaccinations to assisted living facilities, senior housing, and other remote areas would also include pet food distribution.



Volunteer Opportunity:

Every hour volunteered would gain dollar credit at the veterinary clinic to go towards their own pets health needs.

Shared Working Space

TPP collaborates with pet-related businesses and non-profits who may not need or can not afford a large working space, but need to be able to meet with clients outside of the home. Small offices would be rented out on a monthly basis, and meeting rooms or classrooms can be rented out by the hour if needed. Wifi would be available for the workspace as well as in the café for business.



Pet-Friendly Cafe

TPP would have a small snack & coffee shop for visitors. This is so they can enjoy the day longer if wanted! Of course, doggy treats would be available as well!



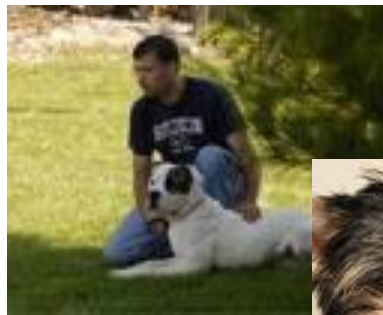
Education Center - Academy

Community Classes

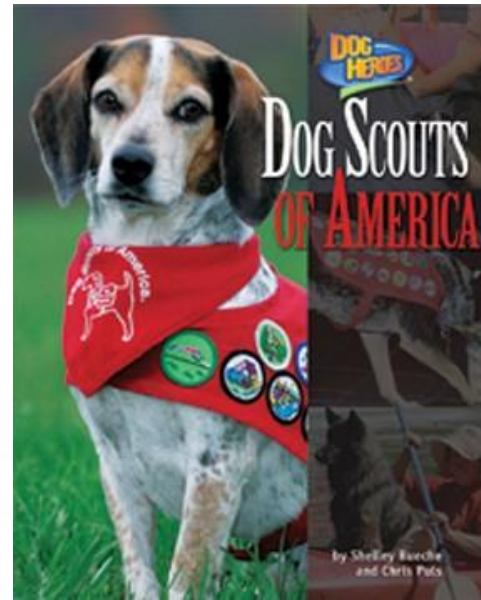

Advocacy groups, breed groups, reading to pets, Health and wellness and more! Join a group or club to support your passion!!

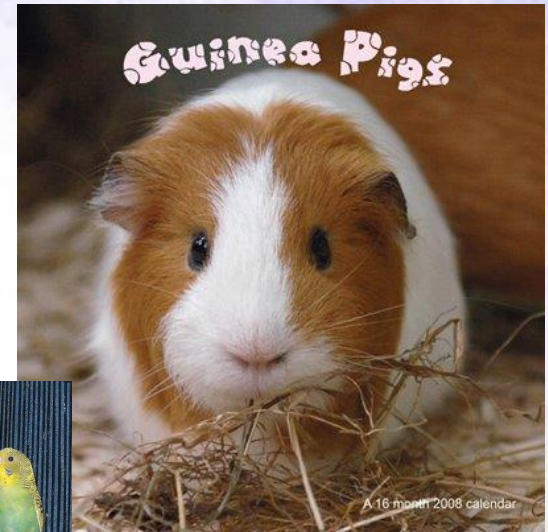

Adoption Program

TPP would partner with local rescues and adopt pets out at a reasonable cost. Pets would come with a spay/neuter, microchip, all shots and general care initially, and provide lifetime necessary vaccinations, and discounted veterinary care for the life of the pet.

Mini Farm



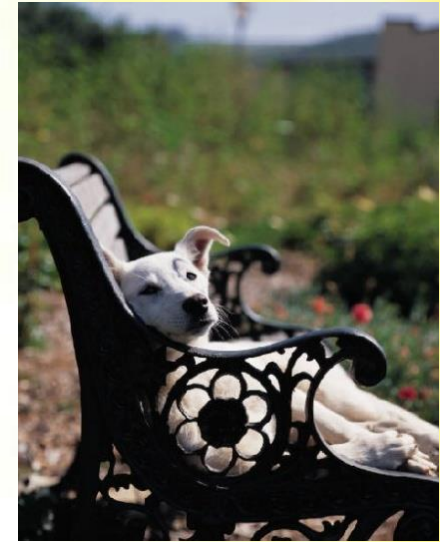

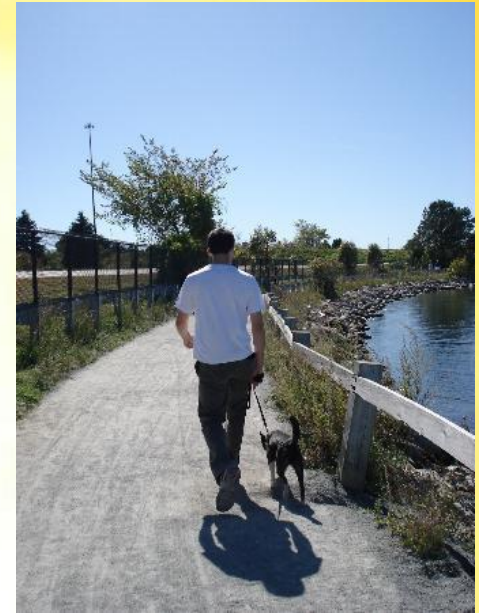
Off-Leash Dog Parks
